

Training and development?



If you are successful at the telephone interview stage, you will then be invited to attend a half-day session in our Wales office, for a final 121 interview. This is a good opportunity to find out more about life at Proxima and ask any questions you might have regarding training, projects and career opportunities. This interview will be split into two parts. The first part will be for you to deliver a short presentation on a topic to be advised 1 week in advance. In the second part of the interview, you will be asked to discuss your interest in Proxima and demonstrate a strong understanding of both our business and the graduate role. You will also have an opportunity to demonstrate the skills and strengths that you can offer Proxima and discuss with your assessor why you are the perfect fit for the Fast Track Programme .
